AWARDS

2010

AAT launched a project in a South Thailand immigration detention center to identify and protect trafficked victims imprisoned as illegal migrants. This effort earned the Immigration Bureau the 2010 national anti-trafficking award from the Thai government.

2018

AAT's Program Coordinator received an award from the Thai Prime Minister on National Anti-Human Trafficking Day.

2020

AAT was awarded by the French Ministry of Foreign Affairs for its engagement in social issues as a French NGO.

2024

AAT received the "HER AWARDS, UNFPA THAILAND 2024" from the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA Thailand), recognizing it as an organization driving social change.
